



The avalanche was triggered by the second skier in a group of two. The first skier safely descended 400' and pulled off into thick trees. The second skier hit a thin and weak spot on the slope and triggered a deep slab avalanche. It broke 10-12 feet deep, ran full width and 1300 feet downslope. No one was caught.
